**NOTE**

1. A separate Military Affidavit must be filed for each person for whom B., C., or D. above applies.

If defendant, an interested party, or an heir-at-law is in military service, the Court shall appoint an attorney to represent that person and protect his/her interest in accordance with the Service Members Civil Relief Act which provides an umbrella of protection whereby those on active duty status can request a delay in proceedings if they can show that their military responsibilities preclude their proper representation in Court.
